- Must complete an Academic All-American Application.
- Carry a grade point average of 3.0 or higher. No D's or F's.
- Schools that do not offer a GPA report card must reflect scores of 3 or higher, S+, or O.
- Provide proof of grades/scores from current year-end report card.

Any player meeting the above criteria and wishing to apply for this prestigious, well-earned recognition must turn in a completed application and an unaltered copy of current year-end report card to the Academic All-American Coordinator no later than June 30th, 2021. An awards recognition event will be held at a date and time to be announced.
